The CSCP is an international not-for-profit think-tank and 'do-tank' born from the collaboration between the two world-renowned institutions: the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and the Wuppertal Institute for Climate, Environment and Energy. The Centre contributes to the Johannesburg Plan of Implementation, signed at the UN World Summit on Sustainable Development in 2002, to promote sustainable patterns of consumption and production (SCP) within the 10-year framework of programmes, which is now called the 'Marrekech Process'.

The CSCP team is looking for open-minded personalities with a high team spirit and the willingness to work in a multicultural and interdisciplinary setting. Students and graduates from different fields of study, e.g. social sciences, humanities, political science, economics, business or environmental science can apply. Proficiency in English (oral and verbal) and a good working knowledge of Office programmes are required.

The tasks of the interns will include literature and internet research, preliminary work in preparing reports, publications and presentations. There is also the possibility to participate in further project activities, e.g. meetings, workshops or the development of acquisition strategies.

The minimum length of an internship at the CSCP is 12 weeks. The internship will not be remunerated.

Past internships in international organisations or companies and proficiency in additional languages would be an advantage.
